We're wishing you a wonderful winter break. As we welcome 2018, Open Door still has openings in both the 3-day and 2-day morning sessions. It's a perfect time for new children to enter in, so please let your friends know. In addition, should you wish to add an afternoon option, while there was not enough interest at this time, we hope to offer an afternoon session on Tuesday afternoon for the 3 day sessions beginning in March. Please let us know if you are interested. Unfortunately there was not enough interest in offering an afternoon session for the 2 day session. The occasional drop in lunch (or signing up for the entire month) is available on Tuesday and Wednesday for the 3 day class and Thursday and Friday for the 2 day class. Be sure to let your child's teacher know your needs with a minimum of 24 hour notice.

This is NEW! Drop Off is Changing!

In an effort to make the transition to school easier for the children (and parents) we have implemented the curbside drop-off procedure starting immediately after break. Please drive into the Northwest entrance and turn left toward the nursery school steps. One teacher will stand waiting for your child. We ask that you drive all the way up to where the teacher is standing. There may eventually be snow piled up near the sidewalk and this will allow your child to exit your car safely. The children will wait on the benches and talk with one another while they wait for everyone to arrive. After everyone is here, we will all enter in together.

If the temperature is 0 or below, or the wind child is -10 or colder, we will start our day inside. On those days we ask that you bring your child inside. (This procedure will also hold true on rainy days.) We will continue to use the IN or OUT sign.

It's great because...

You won't have to take other children out of the car to drop-off your preschooler, children having difficulty separating will have a brief good-bye, and increased verbal interaction will occur while the children wait for others to have an "equal opportunity entrance".

It's a challenge because...

Parents will have to be timely. We will start in the parking lot at 9am/1pm and hope to have all of the children out of their cars soon thereafter. If you arrive late, your child misses the benefit of entering with others. You will have to have messages written in advance or call the school and leave a message. Backpacks and bags will need to be placed near the child and ready to go. We are merely trying to say, this will involve more organization for parents.

Our end of the day pick-up will remain the same. We felt there is a benefit for parents to have a chance to meet one another while waiting together in the hallway. Important messages/reminders are often posted above the take-home box. In addition, parents get to see what's going on in the classroom. We know this will be confusing at first, but we feel the benefits far outweigh the initial confusion. Thank you for helping.

Time to Clean

On the January 15 holiday school is not in session. We will however be at school and hope that everyone will join us for our cleaning day. Supplies including rubber gloves will be provided. Childcare will also be available (provided by some of the volunteer parents in the nursery). A sign up sheet will be posted in the hallway. We will begin at 9:00 and hope to be finished by 11:00. Even if you can only help for an hour, PLEASE Come! Your help is greatly appreciated. Through the generosity of Goodbye Blue Monday, delicious coffee will be available to all! Hope to see you there.
