The Little Bear Video...just a reminder...

On April 8th we will be viewing the video **Little Bear** in class. This is a nationally recognized video featuring animal characters to teach children ways to avoid being sexually abused. We use this video each year and have found it extremely well done. The tape features Little Bear, who has been touched in a way he is not comfortable with and told not to "tell." But he does "tell" and then learns about good touch and bad touch and ways to say no. The company responsible for putting the video together has agreed to send each family a link to the video so parents can view this at home prior to the children's viewing on April 8. Please, **this viewing is for parents only**. We would like your child to view it for the first time in class. If you have not yet returned the signed waiver indicating you will NOT share this with anyone else, please do so when your child returns to school.

**The Little Bear character in this video is NOT the same as Little Bear from the Else Holmelund Minarik/Maurice Sendak books and videos.
